## RV RENTAL HELPFUL TIPS

**POWER FAILURE:** If you have an electrical power failure be sure to check the main power switch usually located near the house entry door. If the main power switch is 'ON' check breaker switches and or fuses that may apply, located inside or outside of the motorhome. Breaker switch will shut off automatically if it becomes overloaded with air conditioners and appliances. If you have difficulty locating breakers, the owner's manuals will help you to locate them.

**LOADING UP:** When loading, don't create road-handling problems by concentrating heavy items on one side, or at the rear or overhead. Items stored in overhead cabinets, especially heavy objects, can fly out in a panic stop or collision. It is a good idea to place any bottles that may break and spill liquids inside a plastic bin.

### THE FOLLOWING TIPS CAN PREVENT DAMAGE AND SAVE YOU MONEY

**WHEN BACKING UP:** ALWAYS HAVE SOMEONE AT THE REAR OF THE MOTORHOME TO CHECK FOR CLEARANCE. There can always be an object such as a short post that would be impossible to see from the side mirrors and much damage results when the bumper is caught on such items. When you take your RV into boondock areas for hunting or fishing, always point the vehicle headed out toward the road. Then, should an emergency require quick departure, you lost no time maneuvering to turn the vehicle around, or risk getting bogged down or backing off the road into a ditch in the darkness.

**EMERGENCY ROOF EXITS:** Are to be opened only in the event of an emergency. They are easily cracked if not opened properly and closed in the same manner.

**ALL OUTSIDE ACCESS DOORS TO OUTSIDE COMPARTMENTS ARE TO BE LOCKED, LATCHED OR SECURED TO PREVENT ANY LOST ITEMS STORED INSIDE THEM.**

**LOCK ENTRY DOOR FROM INSIDE BEFORE TRAVELING:** The door can come open while moving and do damage to the door as well as the motorhome.

**SECURE REFRIGERATOR DOOR:** If food or bottles are not stored properly in the refrigerator, upon opening after traveling they will fall out and possible stain the flooring.

### WHAT TO DO IF....

**WATER BACKS UP INTO THE SHOWER:** The holding tank for waste-water from shower and sinks is probably full. If you are not near a dumping station, you can run excess water into a large pail placed beneath the waste-water (not the sewage) outlet while at a campground. But before you leave the campground, carry the pail to an emptying facility. Because some campers have spoiled campsites by pouring waste-water on them, some states outlaw use of the open pail for this purpose.

**YOU HEAR A MOTOR CUTTING OFF AND ON ALL NIGHT:** It is probably the water pump, installed in many motorhomes to pressurize the water system. Turn off the switch, and make sure all faucets are turned off.

**YOU HAVE A FLAT TIRE:** Call in a pro with a strong back and good equipment. He can jack up the vehicle and handle the heavy wheels easily.

**YOU TURN ON THE FAUCET AND WATER SPUTTERS OUT:** It is probably caused by air in the water tank or lines. Turn on the water pump and open a faucet and let it run to clear the air from the lines. **MAKE SURE YOU DO NOT RUN THE WATER TANK EMPTY WITH THE PUMP ON, THIS COULD CAUSE AIR IN THE LINES AND BURN OUT THE WATER PUMP.**

We have a variety of motorhomes and each and every one is different in some respect. If the above hints do not apply to your particular rental, then check the manual for further details and information.

Please remember these are machines and are subject to Murphy's Law which is "If anything can go wrong, it will." So treat it with respect, try to learn a little about it in the short time you have it and I'm sure you will enjoy it and have a minimum amount of problems.

## FAQ's – Happy Campers RV Rentals

**How much does it cost to rent an RV?** Base pricing varies upon seasonality and includes up to 3 nights, 300 miles, 9 hours of generator usage as well as the cleaning & prep fees; additional nights may be added in 1 night increments. Pickup time is after 2PM on the start date of your reservation. Return time is by 10AM on the end date of your reservation. Unit pickup & return dates are Monday through Friday, excluding holidays, during the allotted times. Should you need to return the unit outside of normal business hours, you are able to do so, however your rental will continue through to the next business day. **What if I need more miles than what are included?** Mileage is billed on a tiered scale in excess of included mileage. The 1<sup>st</sup> tier is the first 250 miles in excess of included mileage billed at \$0.32/mi.; the 2<sup>nd</sup> Tier is the next 250 miles in excess of included mileage billed at \$0.78/mi.; the 3<sup>rd</sup> and Final Tier is anything over 500 miles in excess of included mileage billed at \$1.59/mi..  
**Extra Generator Hours are billed at \$3/hr.**

**What about insurance?** Insurance is not included in the rental pricing. As the renter you have a couple of options. The 1<sup>st</sup> and usually the best option is to have your insurance company issue a binder that is VIN specific and lists Happy Campers RV Rentals as additional insured with coverage of 100/300/50 for the duration of your rental. Should your insurance company not extend coverage to RV Rentals or if you would rather not use your personal insurance the 2<sup>nd</sup> option would be to purchase coverage directly through our insurance company, MBA Insurance, for the duration of your rental. Rental insurance purchased through MBA Insurance has state minimum coverage with a \$1500 deductible.

**Is there a deposit required to reserve an RV?** There is a refundable \$1200 security/damage deposit required to reserve an RV which needs to be paid with a major credit card. The name on the credit card must match the name on the reservation. This deposit holds an RV for your reservation and then becomes your damage deposit during your rental, it also covers additional days, mileage, generator usage, fuel, lost items, any traffic violations, tickets, tolls, etc. Your deposit will be refunded within 10 business days after your return. So long as there is no damage to the unit and no additional charges were incurred during your rental you will receive a full refund back to the original method of payment.

**The actual cost of the rental will need to be paid in full 3 weeks prior to departure.** Payment can be made by cashier's check, money order, personal check, or cash. Credit cards are not accepted for final payment. In the rare event that your only option is to pay for your rental by credit card, there will be a 4% processing fee added to the total of your rental.

**Do I need a special driver's license to drive the RV?** No, you must have a valid driver's license present at the time of departure and be at least 25 years of age. Additional drivers will need to present a valid driver's license and be at least 25 years of age.  
**Happy Campers RV Rentals reserves the right to refuse service to anyone for any reason.**

**Is it difficult to drive a motorhome?** No, driving a motorhome is similar to driving a large SUV, it isn't difficult it's just different. Extra care is expected when driving a motorhome.

**Are there any additional fees that I will be charged?** Aside from extra miles and extra generator hours used there are no additional standard fees. The unit must be returned with a full tank of fuel to avoid being assessed a fee for Happy Campers RV Rentals to re-fuel the unit for you.

**Can I take the RV to Canada or Mexico?** Travel to Canada is allowed. Travel to Mexico is **prohibited**.

**Are pets allowed in the RV?** We are pet friendly, there is a 1x fee of \$125 allowing dogs up to 30 lbs. to join you during your rental.

**Is smoking allowed in the RV?** Smoking is strictly prohibited, the main concern being the health of subsequent renters.

**Can we tow behind the motorhome?** Towing is permitted with pre-written approval by Happy Campers RV Rentals for a 1x flat fee of \$49 & an additional \$0.10/mi. so long as the gross weight does not exceed the vehicles towing capacity and maximum weight limit.

**How many people can ride in the motorhome?** The number of occupants should not exceed the number of seatbelts equipped in the unit.

**Can I park my vehicle on your lot during my rental?** Yes, you may park your vehicle on our lot free of charge, however, we are not responsible for any damage or theft. For added security our entrance gates are locked after business hours but your vehicle will remain accessible 24/7.

**What amenities does the RV come equipped with?** The RV has an awning that is as simple to use as the push of a button; you may use the awning at no cost while accepting full responsibility for damage no matter the cause. Every unit has a TV, DVD Player, and Stereo for your entertainment, along with a Keurig coffee brewer for your enjoyment.

**What if I return the RV early?** There will not be any refunds or credits given for late departure or early return do to scheduling availability for other clients.
